

Phillips Exeter Academy Application Procedures

- Please submit the Candidate Profile as soon as possible so that a file can be established in your name. Once the Candidate Profile is submitted, you will be able to monitor your application status electronically.
- If you are disabled and believe you will require any special accommodations during the application or interview process, please alert the director of admissions so that the matter may be reviewed in a timely fashion.

Required Application Materials

DEADLINES

- All application materials are due no later than **January 15, 2010** to guarantee a March 10 decision.
- All financial aid materials are due no later than **February 1, 2010**.
- Admissions decisions will be sent on **March 10, 2010**.
- For accepted applicants, enrollment deposit is due **April 10, 2010**.

CANDIDATE PROFILE

- Submit as early as possible.
- The Candidate Profile may be mailed or submitted electronically at www.exeter.edu/admissions/howtoapply. Electronic submission is preferred.
- Submit the Candidate Profile only once. Choose either the electronic **or** paper version, not both.

SCHOOL REPORT AND TRANSCRIPTS

Guidelines

- The School Report must be completed by the appropriate official at your school.
- Transcripts for the past full school year are required.
- Transcripts for the most recent full marking period are required.

Submission

- The School Report and transcripts must be mailed to us in an envelope sealed and signed on the flap by the official who completed the form.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Guidelines

- English and Math recommendations must be completed by your current teachers, not teachers from a prior year (see exception in Block Scheduling in the Additional Information section).
- The Extracurricular recommendation must be completed by an adult who teaches or provides guidance to you in a non-academic area.

Submission

- English, Math, and Extracurricular recommendations may either be mailed to us in an envelope sealed and signed on the flap by the official who completed the form, or submitted electronically to admit@exeter.edu by the official who completed the form.

STUDENT ESSAYS

- Handwritten responses are required. In addition, a typed version is encouraged.

PARENT STATEMENT

- Optional. We welcome, but do not require, input from your parent(s).

OTHER MATERIALS

- Please do **not** send us copies of your certificates and awards. You may use the Extracurricular Activities space on the Candidate Profile to tell us about your achievements.

TESTING

Applicants for **grades 9 and 10**

- You must submit ISEE or SSAT test results.
- Results must be from tests taken September 2009 or later.
- Results must be sent directly to Exeter from the testing company. We cannot accept test results from the family because the required writing sample is not included.

Applicants for **grade 11**

- You must submit results from one of the following tests: ISEE, SSAT, SAT Reasoning Test, or PSAT.
- If submitting the ISEE or SSAT, test results must be:
 - From tests taken September 2009 or later.
 - Sent directly to Exeter from the testing company.
- If submitting the SAT or PSAT:
 - We require your most recent results.
 - Results may be submitted on the official school transcript, directly from the College Board, or photocopied from the family's report.

Applicants for **grade 12 or Post-Graduate year**

- You must submit recent PSAT, ACT, or SAT Reasoning Test results.
- Results may be submitted on the official school transcript, directly from the College Board, or photocopied from the family's report.

School Codes

- ISEE 300185; SSAT 5764; SAT 1884; TOEFL 8128

Applicants for whom English is not the primary or fluent language

- If English is not your first language and has not been the primary language of instruction for your most recent four years of schooling, you are required to submit a recent TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score.

INTERVIEW

- A personal interview is required of all applicants.
- You are encouraged to schedule your interview as soon as possible.

On-Campus

- On-campus interviews must be scheduled no later than **January 15, 2010** and conducted by **January 31, 2010** to guarantee a March 10 decision.

Phillips Exeter Academy embraces the ideal of Universal Access on our campus. Many of our building entrances and interiors are accessible.

Off-Campus

- Applicants must request an off-campus interview by checking the appropriate box on the Candidate Profile. The request must be received no later than **January 15, 2010** to guarantee a March 10 decision.

HOMESCHOOLED APPLICANTS

- Homeschooled applicants must submit additional information which addresses their unique situation.
- Please refer to the [Guidelines for Homeschooled Applicants](#).

TRANSLATIONS

- An English translation is required of all documents that have been completed in a language other than English in order to guarantee a March 10 decision.
- Additionally we require the originals of all documents (transcripts, recommendations, etc.) even if the originals are not in English.

BLOCK SCHEDULE

- If you are not currently taking English we require recommendations from your current history/humanities teacher **plus** last year's English teacher.
- If you are not currently taking math we require recommendations from your current science teacher **plus** last year's math teacher.

CANDIDATE PROFILE AND COMMON RECOMMENDATIONS

- The Candidate Profile is accepted at the following schools: Deerfield Academy, Groton School, The Hotchkiss School, The Lawrenceville School, Phillips Academy, Phillips Exeter Academy, St. Paul's School, and The Taft School.
- The enclosed English and Math Recommendations and School Report forms are accepted by the following members of the Ten School Admission Organization: Choate Rosemary Hall, Deerfield Academy, The Hill School, The Hotchkiss School, The Lawrenceville School, The Loomis Chaffee School, Phillips Academy, Phillips Exeter Academy, St. Paul's School, and The Taft School.

LATE APPLICATIONS

- Check our website at www.exeter.edu/admissions to learn if we are accepting late applications.
- Decisions and notifications on late applications will be made on a rolling basis. Please complete all required parts of the application as soon as possible.
- If late applications are being accepted, interview scheduling will begin April 15, 2010.

Financial Aid

Guidelines

- Families who anticipate needing financial aid at any time during their child's career at Exeter should apply for aid at the time of the admissions application.
- It is not possible for Exeter to consider requests for financial assistance after admission decisions are made.
- Students who qualify for financial aid may be in a more competitive situation for admission to Exeter.
- International students are eligible to receive financial aid. However, Exeter has limited funds available for this purpose.

Submission

- **All financial aid materials must be sent directly to SSS by NAIS.** Please see inside of this folder for address information.
- To apply for financial aid, check the appropriate box on the Candidate Profile. We will send you detailed information about Exeter's financial aid program and policies.
- The following must be submitted to *SSS by NAIS* no later than **February 1, 2010**:
 - Parents' Financial Statement (PFS). Can be started as early as **November 1, 2009**. You are encouraged to complete the PFS online at [SSS by NAIS](#) to speed processing time. Paper forms are available by request from Exeter's financial aid office, 603-777-3637.
 - Signed copies of your family's 2008 federal tax return (1040), including all supporting schedules and forms
 - 2008 W-2s and/or 1099s (if applicable)
 - 2009 W-2s and/or 1099s (if applicable)
 - Non-US residents: submit official Income/Asset Verification Forms for 2008 such as foreign tax returns and/or wage statements.
- The following must be submitted to *SSS by NAIS* as soon as possible:
 - Signed copy of your 2009 Federal Tax return, including all supporting schedules and forms.
 - Non-US residents: submit official Income/Asset Verification Forms for 2009 such as foreign tax returns and/or wage statements.Any award that is made prior to receiving the 2009 tax return or income verification forms is tentative. This documentation is required in order to make a final award of financial aid.
- In a divorced or separated family, a separate PFS must be submitted for each household.
- Please be sure to list Phillips Exeter Academy as a recipient of the Report of Family Contribution (RFC). Our school code is 5764.
