Time Factors Governing The Tournament:

- All games will be played with six-minute quarters. In all games EXCEPT the Championship Game, there will be just two minutes between periods, three minutes at the half. If, however, we fall behind schedule, the periods for any games EXCEPT the Semi-Final Games and the Championship Game may be reduced to five minutes.
- Overtime periods (2 minutes each) will be played ONLY in the Semi-Final games and the Championship Game.
- During ALL games each team will be allowed just one one-minute and one twenty-second time-out during each half. In the case of overtime in one of the Semi-Final Games or the Championship Game, each team will be allowed one full time-out in the overtime periods.

Bracket Standing Tie-Breakers:

- Level One: Results of the games between the tied teams.
- Level Two: The team that gave up the least number of goals in games between the two tied teams and their common opponents.
- Level Three: Goal Differential in the games between the two tied teams and their common opponents.
- Level Four: A shootout between the two tied teams.

RULES: The tournament will be played under current NCAA Rules. In particular, the five meter line will be utilized, with a direct shot off a free throw allowed only from behind the five (outside the yellow markers). The shot clock will be 30 seconds. The teams and the re-entry areas, however, will be on the side nearest the table. Teams will trade ends after each period.
