Left at 11:00, arrived at Trinity at 1:30. Races began at 3:30 on 10-min intervals. B/G4,3,2,1 Sunny and hot, 85 degrees. Strong following current with strong SW head winds creating rough water and one-foot swells, esp in last 1000m after bridge. Appeared to be more current in right lane, and thus no close races. Exeter's G1 looked poised and strong, handling rough water well. Exeter's B1 lost skeg (river was full of floating logs) in warmup, delaying the start for forty minutes. In the B1 race, with the crews even off the line, Exeter again lost their skeg 48 seconds into the race. The race was called due to the late hour in the day." Trailer and buses left about 6 and arrived home by 8:30.
