The Anja S. Greer Conference on Secondary School Mathematics, Science and Technology is pleased to announce four full-tuition scholarships for mathematics teachers from northern New Hampshire, Vermont or Maine.

The Anja S. Greer Conference, in its 28th year, is a week-long residential conference for mathematics and science teachers. Each participant takes two ten-hour courses during the week in addition to attending evening presentations by nationally known speakers. Those interested should go to www.exeter.edu/mst for detailed information and a list of courses.

Each year, a pair of mathematics teachers will be selected from two schools from northern New Hampshire, Vermont or Maine as recipients of the scholarships which include tuition fees, room and board, and all course materials. Awarding scholarships to a pair of teachers from one school will allow the teachers to mutually support each other as they try out new ideas during the school year.
