



1) Fire Drills: The Academy requires five fire drills to be conducted each academic year in all dormitories; three to be completed prior to November 15th and during winter term, prior to March 15th. These drills are conducted by campus safety officers in cooperation with the dorm heads. Three drills are mandated during our six-week summer school program

2) All dormitories are equipped with heat and smoke detectors. Building fire alarm systems are hardwired directly to the Exeter Fire Department, which is located just one block from the eastside of our campus. Many of our buildings are equipped with sprinkler systems. New sprinkler systems are installed during new construction and whenever an existing building undergoes a major renovation. All dormitories will have sprinkler systems by September 2008.

3) Students are encouraged to comply with the following:

- Know the location of the fire exits in your dormitory. Exits must remain clear.
- Know where the extinguishers are kept in your dormitory.
- Know the location of the fire alarm pull stations in your dormitory.
- Some buildings have outside fire escapes--familiarize yourself with these locations.
- Immediately report defective electrical outlets and wiring to your custodian.

The office of Campus Safety examines all of the 600+ fire extinguishers on campus. Extinguishers are inspected monthly and are tested by an outside vendor on a yearly basis. There is at least one fire extinguisher located on each floor in every dormitory and academic building.
