



- Always lock your room and take your key. Do not leave your key in the door lock or in an area near your room.
- Do not admit strangers into your dormitory or into your room.
- Always walk in lighted areas when traveling on campus after dark.
- Always travel in groups after dark.
- Do not take short cuts behind buildings or through secluded areas.
- Do not jump off the Hill Bridge or swim in the river.
- Do not go beyond Court Street, behind health services, or into Swasey Parkway after dark.
- Use care when crossing streets. Always use crosswalks.
- Evacuate the building immediately when the building fire alarm system activates or if evidence of a fire is present.
- Report all individual room and smoke detector activations to your dorm head or custodian immediately. Do not tamper with detectors.
- Notify your dorm head of any and all problems immediately.
- Do not go up on the roofs of school buildings.
- Report all suspicious persons and activity to the office Campus Safety, ext. 4444.

Emergency phones are strategically placed around campus and provide a direct connection with the Exeter fire and police departments. These phones are located in academic buildings and selected outdoor locations. A blue light helps to identify the outdoor emergency phones.
